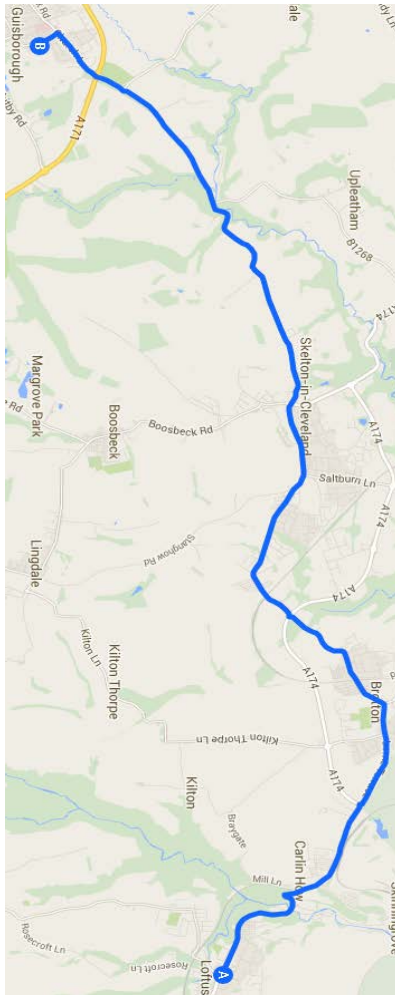

Timings & routes

The timings shown are approximate and will depend on traffic, road works, weather and so forth. We would always recommend that you arrive at least 5 minutes before the designated times.

Pick up points

Pick up points may be **at any recognised bus stop on the designated route**. In the first few weeks of the year there is a lot of uncertainty from drivers and students; therefore please make sure they know you want to get on the bus by putting your arm out!

Bus fares

These are commercial routes and fares will be taken on the bus per journey. Fares will be subject to students having a council half fare pass.

Local authority reduced fare passes

(Redcar and Cleveland Council Residents only)

Students need to apply for a reduced fare pass (RAT Card) from their local authority to be eligible for reduced fares. Prior Pursglove College will pay for all students passes upon enrolment. Please bring your completed form, note that we will use your student ID badge photo.

Application forms will be posted to all students before enrolment. Alternatively forms will be available from college website and from your local council offices. Students must have a reduced fare bus pass to be eligible for reduced fares.

Changes to routes/times:

If there are any changes, these will be advertised on the Portal and/or via student e-mail. We therefore advise you to check the portal and your e-mails regularly. If you are still unsure, please do ask the bus drivers for further clarification.
