Pre Supported Internship

The Pre Supported Internship is designed to give you a taster of the world of employment, whilst still developing all of your academic skills.

You will get the opportunity to try out a range of different volunteering opportunities inside the college and outside, with a focus on employability and soft skills.

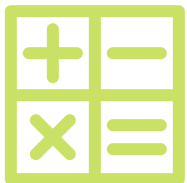
You will participate in enterprise projects and host your own events and be involved in the planning stages whilst working as a team.

This course will give you all the experiences you need ready for the supported internship.



Maths and English

In Pre Supported Internship you need to study functional skills Maths and English at the right level for you. Your teachers will help choose which qualification is right for you.



Supported Internship

If you are ready for the world of work, the Supported Internship is the course for you. The aim of the course is to achieve paid employment or volunteering opportunities.

You will develop all the fundamental skills needed for the workplace through a range of activities and sessions delivered by our job coaches. You will be given advice on how to apply for jobs, gain and keep employment, and create a work-ready CV.

You will work with our job coaches to find a range of work placements in line with your interests and aspirations, and participate in unpaid work experience for at least six months.

This course is individual to you and the staff work with you to make sure you achieve your goals.

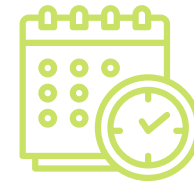

Tutor

In both pathways you will have a tutor who will work with you and support you while you are at college. They are your first point of contact at college.



Facilities

We have a range of facilities in Endeavour for you. We have different social spaces that are supervised by staff. There is access to the canteen and Student Central where you can get breakfast and lunch.

On this pathway, you also get access to the Adult Skills Centre. This purpose built facility allows you to be more independent. There are work spaces, chill-out rooms and kitchen facilities. This space is designed to feel like a work environment.

Transport

On this pathway we will be developing your independent travel skills. You can come on the college bus which costs £1 a day and collects from a range of locations in the Tees Valley and North Yorkshire. We can support you by giving you travel training.
